SAFETY TIPS FOR BICYCLISTS

Each year there are about 800 bicycle-related deaths in the United States and another half-million bicycle-related injuries that are treated in hospital emergency rooms.

Here are safety tips for bike riders:

- Protect your head by wearing a helmet.
- See and be seen.
Wear bright fluorescent colors during the day.
- Avoid biking at night, but if you do, equip your bicycle with headlights and taillights and wear reflective clothing.
- Be alert for obstacles in your path.
- Go with the flow; ride with traffic.
- Be aware of traffic around you.
Learn the rules of the road and obey traffic laws.
- Be sure your bicycle is properly adjusted.
Check brakes before riding and check your wheels.
